## Outdoor Fireplace

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

**Guest understands that the use of the fireplace is at the Guest's own risk.**

- Guest agrees to never leave the fireplace unattended and agree to turn off the gas valves after use. Please use utmost precaution when in operation.
- Guest agrees to report any issues or safety concerns with the fireplace to the property host as soon as possible by email.
- Fireplaces can be a source of fire danger, and air pollution. Smoke is especially harmful for adults and children with asthma or other respiratory diseases, or heart problems.

<p><b>*A propane tank fuels the outdoor fireplace.</b> <b>You may refill the tank at any local grocery store and most gas stations.</b></p> <p><b>Step 1:</b> Open the gas valve located behind the fireplace.</p>	
<p><b>Step 2:</b> Open the valve on the front of the fireplace.</p>	
<p><b>Step 3</b> <b>Exercise caution during this step.</b> Use a long lighter to light the gas.</p>	
<p><b>WHEN YOU ARE DONE USING THE FIREPLACE. PLEASE TURN BOTH THE FRONT AND BACK GAS VALVES OFF. ENSURE THE FIRE IS NO LONGER BURNING AND GAS IS IN THE OFF POSITION.</b></p>
